

Ethnopoly is a game that promotes cultural diversity. Its aim is to create positive images of other cultures in a fun way. It is also a platform for people of different origins to meet.

14th edition in Meyrin on Friday 24 May 2024!

The teams:

They are composed of 4 to 5 children aged 10 to 11, 7th year primary school pupils from Meyrin-Cointrin schools, accompanied by an adult.

The stations:

Throughout the day (or half-day), around 70 residents, professionals, associations and institutions of Meyrin welcome the teams to their homes or premises to give them a 15-minute presentation on an aspect of their culture, a feature of Meyrin or a particular skill.

How the game works:

With the help of a map, the children choose the places they want to visit. At each station, they discover a theme: the ingredients of paella, how to make Gruyère cheese, Arabic writing, how to tie a sari... but also waste sorting at the recycling centre, the town council or the activities of local societies.

The aim of the game:

To accumulate cultural wealth by meeting the inhabitants of Meyrin and discovering the town. Each team receives points for visiting the stations. To win, a team must meet as many people as possible. The day ends with a snack, a show and prizes for the three teams that have accumulated the most points.
